Item(s) 6: Abeyance in regard to Cluster Developments in the Town of Red Oak

Zoning Administrator Jackie Johnson presented this item. Johnson explained to the Board that after talking with the Planning Board and Chad Meadows of CodeWright Planners this would be the best action by the Town to make sure the Planning Board and Council can work together and make changes to the Cluster Development language in the Land Development and Usage Ordinances.
