Other: Mayor Langley advised the board that due to a fifteen percent (15%) increase sewer rates will have to increase from thirty dollars (\$30) to forty dollars (\$40) for the first one thousand (1,000) gallons for customers. Currently the Town is in the hole each month but, this only slightly closes that gap. After discussion, a motion to approve the increase was made by Commissioner Briley and seconded by Commissioner Bennett. **Motion carried (3-0)**
Commissioner Bennett stated that there will not be a literacy camp this year. The church is currently pivoting to other missions.
