2. Write a short essay of 500 words or less explaining why you have chosen to further your education in the field you have chosen and describe the significance your career choice may have in the community.
3. Attend an interview with the H.B.A. Scholarship Committee.
4. Volunteer 12 hours of community service to the H.B.A.'s Maple in April Festival before, during, or after the festival.
5. If awarded the H.B.A. Scholarship, submit a copy of your first semester transcript by mail to the: Hadley Business Association, ATTN: SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE, P.O. Box 141, Hadley, NY 12835. This will show your intent and proficiency in your major subject to maintain a g.p.a. of 2.85 or better.
6. After receiving a copy of your transcript we will mail you your \$350 Scholarship check.
