Submit completed application to: Hadley Business Association, ATTN: SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE, P.O. Box 141, Hadley, NY 12835 by APRIL 1st.
- 2. Write a short essay explaining why you have chosen to further your education in the field you have chosen and describe the significance your career choice may have in the community.
- 3. Attend an interview with the H.B.A. Scholarship Committee.
- 4. Volunteer 12 hours of community service to the H.B.A.'s Maple in April Festival before, during, or after the festival.
- 5. If awarded the H.B.A. Scholarship, submit a copy of your first semester transcript by mail to the: Hadley Business Association, ATTN: SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE, P.O. Box 141, Hadley, NY 12835. This will show your intent and proficiency in your major subject to maintain a g.p.a. of 2.85 or better.
- 6. After receiving a copy of your transcript we will mail you your \$350 Scholarship check.
